BAHASA INDONESIA UNTUK DUNIA

➤ Overview

Bahasa Indonesia untuk Penutur Asing (BIPA) is a special program for foreigners who are interested in Indonesian language and Culture. It provides participants with the opportunity to acquire communicative competence both in spoken and written Bahasa Indonesia. **The Indonesian language and Culture Course at Yogyakarta State University is aimed to give the initial knowledge and experience on how to communicate with Indonesian language; to introduce and open students' insight about the diverse culture in Indonesia; to teach Indonesian language as a daily communicative language and some other specific purposes.** The situation of learning Indonesian language at Yogyakarta State University is made comfortable. Therefore, several approaches are used, among others are:

➤ Program Excellence:

Direct pertinence to real-life situations and constant interaction are emphasized.

Qualified instructors and tutors are trained in both the natural approach and communicative teaching method. Every course is conducted on the basis of participants 'needs.

Private custom-designed course packages are also available.

Tailor made-design course packages are also available.

➤ Models of Learning

Below are the models of learning that is performed during the course.

➤ **Lecturing:** Students will learn language with lecturers in class.

➤ **Tutorials:** Tutors as students' assistants will give some exercises and activities to strengthen the learning outcomes with lecturers. Tutorial activity will be more practical; can be either inside or outside the classroom.

➤ **Workshop:** Workshop model is chosen so that students can experience the process of learning art and culture in Indonesia directly. They are batik, Indonesian culinary, pencak silat, and gamelan workshop.

➤ **Excursion:** Through excursions, students will get to know Indonesia closer in social communities, tourism, and cultural heritage. The excursion will be conducted by visiting tourist

destination, cultural heritage, company, school, etc. It is also conducted in the form of Live-In Program where the students will have real experience to stay with families in the village. The participants will participate in the daily activities, such as farming, making handicrafts, and assisting in the homes of villagers.

➤ **Programs**

Indonesian Language and Culture Course at Yogyakarta State University provide 3 programs, namely: Regular Program, Private Program, and Tailor-Made Program.

➤ **Regular Program**

The program is held every semester according to the university academic calendar and is divided into three levels according to students' proficiency: elementary, intermediate, and advanced. In the first semester, students are exposed to general Bahasa Indonesia. Meanwhile, on the second semester, they will be provided with Bahasa Indonesia for Academic Purposes.

➤ **Private Program**

This program is designed for individuals depend on their needs. There is one teacher for one student. It can also be conducted for a small group (less than 4 persons/group).

➤ **Tailor-Made Program**

This program is designed for special request. It can be in the form of credit transfer, Indonesian language training, and other specific purposes course.

➤ **Venue**

Each course is conducted at the Office of International Affairs and Partnerships of Yogyakarta State University. The private and tailor made program is conducted according to the participants' need.

➤ **Facilities**

1. Professional instructors
2. Module of learning materials
3. Air-conditioned and integrated classrooms
4. Academic Certificate and Transcript
5. Free internet (Wi-Fi) connection
6. Visit to formal institutions: schools and museums



7. Outbound activity in a tourism village*

10. Information of accommodations (lodgings, home stays)
11. Information of transportation and accommodation (bicycle rentals, motorcycle rentals)
12. Excursion to historical and cultural places (Sultan Palace, Taman sari Water Castle, Imogiri Royal Cemetery)
13. Cultural Workshops (Batik workshop, gamelan workshop, traditional massage workshop, mask workshop, pottery workshop, Angklung workshop, etc.)
